



Welcome to Sea Wolf Adventures,

*Important message!* This is a wilderness trip that requires participants to be physically fit and come prepared with proper footwear and clothing for moderate hiking in the forest and on rocky terrain. Bear viewing areas are subject to change without warning due to weather, or lack of sightings.

We are looking forward to hosting you on board the Sea Wolf for a day of discovery and fun!

### **Grizzly bear viewing**

During the months of June and July, viewing is mostly boat based as the grizzlies will be foraging on sedge grass and turning over rocks on the beaches. During the months of August to October will mostly be on land as this is when the salmon arrive.

For the ***Grizzly Bears of the Wild*** tour we ask that you arrive at **1514 Broughton Blvd.** in Port McNeil (same building as MacKay Whale Watching) at **6:45am daily**. When you arrive you will be greeted by your guide, who will go over safety rules, the itinerary for the day, and take you down to the boat.



If you are staying in Alert Bay you **must** notify us by email or a phone call at least **24 hours** in advance. We will pick you up at the government dock at 7:20am. Please ask your accommodation's receptionist for directions to the dock.

### **Reminder to bring: if raining!**

- Waterproof jacket
- Waterproof pants
- Waterproof hiking boots or knee-high rubber boots
- Insect repellent

### **Reminder to bring: if sunny!**

- Hat
- Sunblock
- Insect repellent

### **Reminder to bring all of the time:**

- Camera
- Medication (if needed)
- Dietary needs (diabetics, allergies)

### **Included in the trip:**

- Boat Transportation
- Breakfast, lunch, snacks, and drinks
- Binoculars
- Cultural sustainability fee
- Rain Poncho (sizes small to large)

To ensure that our tour has a minimal impact on wildlife, we ask that you wear dark clothing. If you bring a camera, please turn your flash off, it scares the bears.

Prior to departure, please use the restroom if needed. We do have one on board, however it not a standup kind. We will make a toilet pit stop half way to the viewing areas; approx 1.5 hours after departure.
