Sea Wolf Adventures, Wildlife and Cultural Expedition departs from Alder Bay. Please meet us by the front office at Alder Bay Resort at 8:45am for the morning departure and 1:15pm for the afternoon departure.

Alder Bay is located along the road to Telegraph Cove. Take the Beaver Cove Rd exit off of Highway 19 towards Telegraph Cove. There is a sign for Alder Bay along Beaver Code Rd. Turn left onto Alder Bay Rd. Drive along this road until you get to the campground. If you reach Telegraph Cove, you have gone too far and will need to back track.

Parking at Alder Bay Resort is \$5. Please pay at the front office.



We can also meet guests in Alert Bay at the U'mista Cultural Centre at 9:15am for the morning departure, and 1:45pm for the afternoon departure. Please inform us 24hours prior to your tour if you choose this option.

Before heading out on the water your guide will go over the safety rules, the itinerary for the day, and answer any questions you may have. Prior to departure, please use the restroom if needed, and alert us to any medical conditions you might have.

Floater suits are provided for your safety and warmth. The suits are unisex and come in XS-XXL. We will get in touch prior to your tour to find out what sizes your group needs.
