



Tour: Wildlife and Cultural Expedition

Welcome! We are looking forward to hosting you for a day of discovery and fun!

Sea Wolf Adventures, Wildlife and Cultural Expedition departs from North Island Marina in Port McNeill at 9:00 am daily (running June 15th to July 14th and September 1st to September 30th). Please meet us at MacKay Whale Watching at 8:45 am for departure. MacKay Whale Watching is located at 1514 Broughton Blvd.

Take the Campbell Way exit off of Highway 19 past Port McNeill Airport. Take Campbell Way to the end and turn left on Broughton Blvd. North Island Marina and MacKay Whale Watching are at the next intersection (Broughton and Beach Drive). If you pass the World's Largest Burl photo stop on the left, you've gone too far and will need to backtrack. Parking in the area is \$5. Please pay at the blue self serve kiosks along the waterfront. We can also meet guests in Alert Bay at the U'mista Cultural Centre at 9:15 am for departure. Please inform us 24 hours prior to your tour if you choose this option.



Before heading out on the water your guide will go over the safety rules, the itinerary for the day, and answer any questions you may have. Prior to departure, please use the restroom if needed, and alert us to any medical conditions you might have.

Floater suits are provided for your safety and warmth. The suits are unisex and come in XS-XXL. We will get in touch prior to your tour to find out what sizes your group needs.

Reminder: *The day that you book may be a windy day, with a bumpy ride home and not recommended for people with neck or back problems, pregnant women, persons with osteoporosis, nor very young children.*

Reminder to bring:

- Waterproof jacket
- Waterproof pants (no jeans)
- Waterproof hiking boots
- Dietary needs (diabetics, allergies)

Included in the Trip:

- Boat transportation
- Binoculars
- Cultural sustainability fee
- Survival/floater suit (XS - XXL)
