



Tour: Grizzly Bears of the Wild

Welcome! We are looking forward to hosting you for a day of discovery and fun!

For the Grizzly Bears of the Wild tour we ask that you arrive at 1514 Broughton Blvd. in Port McNeill (same building as MacKay Whale Watching) at 6:45am.



If you are staying in Alert Bay **you must notify us by email or a phone call at least 24 hours in advance.** We will pick you up at the government dock at 7:20am. Please ask your accommodation's receptionist for directions to the dock.

When you arrive you will be greeted by your guide, who will go over safety rules, the itinerary for the day, and take you down to the boat. At this time please alert us to any medical conditions you might have. Prior to departure, please use the restroom if needed. We do have one on board, however it's not as comfortable.

Reminder: This is a wilderness trip that requires participants to be physically fit and come prepared with proper footwear and clothing for moderate hiking in the forest and on rocky terrain. Bear viewing areas are subject to change without warning due to weather, or lack of sightings.

Reminder to bring:

- Hiking boots are recommended
- Hat
- Sunblock
- Insect repellent
- Camera
- Medication (if needed)
- Dietary needs (diabetics, allergies)

Included in trip:

- Boat transportation
- Breakfast, lunch, snacks, and drinks
- Binoculars
- Cultural sustainability fee
- Rain Poncho (sizes small to large)
